General Information

Cool MMS is a fun, exciting and versatile, **MULTI-PAGE, TEMPLATE-driven MMS composer** for Nokia 3650 / 7650 / 6600 phones. Cool MMS takes creating and sending MMS messages to the next level. By using Cool MMS you can create impressive MMS's for just about any occasion. Impress your friends with your Cool MMS software today !

Cool MMS creates MMS messages as images (pages) with sounds based on templates that contain editable items (images, sounds and text) which can be chosen by the user to personalise the message.

Cool MMS includes a bunch of templates for common everyday occasions plus a set of generic templates if you want to send simpler messages. Additional templates in a wide range of categories can be downloaded and

installed so that you can keep on creating different cool MMSs.

Cool MMS also includes other features such as preview as you are editing, a planner to remind you when to send a message, online access to template servers with the ability to download templates online, and ability to set MMS sizes, making your MMS messages acceptable by other MMS capable mobile phones.

Cool MMS can be freely evaluated without imposing any time limits, and its full functionality is only limited by the actual sending of the messages. To be able to send MMS messages from Cool MMS you must therefore purchase an unlock key.

Requirements

Compatible Phones:

- Nokia 3650
- Nokia 7650
- Nokia 6600

Storage:

- 196 kB (SIS install file)
- 331 kB (installed, minimum)
- Extra storage may be required for new templates.

Installation / Removal of Cool MMS

Cool MMS software is packaged into a standard SIS file named **CoolMMS_S60_V104.sis**. The software provides full functionality of creating MMS messages without imposing any time limits. Actual sending of these messages requires an unlock key to be purchased.

Installation

Note:

- During the installation procedure a dialog may appear specifying that the identity of the supplier cannot be verified. It is safe to proceed, so please continue with the installation.

1. Establish a connection from your PC to your phone via an infra-red or bluetooth connection.
 2. If you have **PC Suite for Nokia 3650** installed, double click the **CoolMMS_S60_V104.sis** in File Explorer to start the installation process and follow the install prompts.
 3. Otherwise manually transfer **CoolMMS_S60_V104.sis** to your phone via the infra-red or bluetooth connection. After the transfer is complete, a New Message will be present in your phone's INBOX.
 4. Open the message to start the installation and follow the prompts.
2. An entry called **Cool MMS** should be listed if already installed. Highlight the entry and select **Options** - > **Remove**. A removal confirmation dialog will appear.
 3. Select **Yes** to remove application.

Installation / Removal of Cool MMS Templates

Cool MMS templates are packaged into a Cool MMS Template Package WCP file, i.e. **0000110T00025.wcp**. The package may contain 1 or more templates.

Installation

Notes:

- To install templates from a Cool MMS Template Package WCP file you must have **Cool MMS** software installed otherwise the phone will not recognise the file format.
- Prior to **Cool MMS** v1.02 templates were installed using standard SIS files. These SIS files are no longer supported and must not be used.

After a successful installation the Cool MMS icon will appear at the bottom of the main view and can be moved to the top left corner for convenience as shown in **Figure 1**.

Additionally, the message containing **CoolMMS_S60_V104.sis** can be deleted to save space on the phone.

Removal

Note:

- Removing Cool MMS will delete all drafts and templates.
1. Run the **Applications Manager** tool usually located in the **Tools** folder of the main view.

1. Transfer the Cool MMS Template Package WCP file onto the phone, see above notes.
2. Open the Cool MMS Template Package WCP file from the phones Messaging or Wap browser application. **Cool MMS** will now start and will display install prompt as shown in **Figure 2** (single template) and **Figure 3** (5 templates).

3. Select **Yes** to proceed and install the template(s) or select **No** to abort installation and exit Cool MMS.
4. If you selected **Yes** the view will be changed to the **Templates** view, new template(s) are automatically recognised and placed in their category folders. The successful template install notification is then displayed as shown in **Figure 4**.
5. After a successful install you can return to Messaging or Wap browser application by exiting **Cool MMS**, select **Back** then select **Exit**.

If **Cool MMS** cannot recognise the Cool MMS Template Package WCP file then the prompt in **Figure 5** will display and **Cool MMS** will exit.

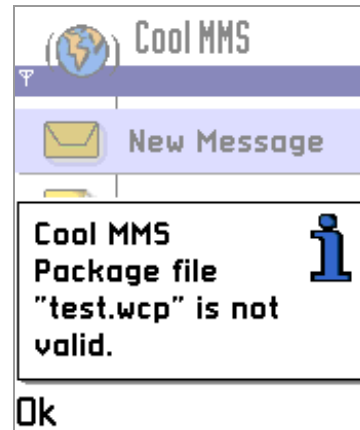

If **Cool MMS** is not compatible with the version of the Cool MMS Template Package WCP file then the prompt in **Figure 6** will display and **Cool MMS** will exit.

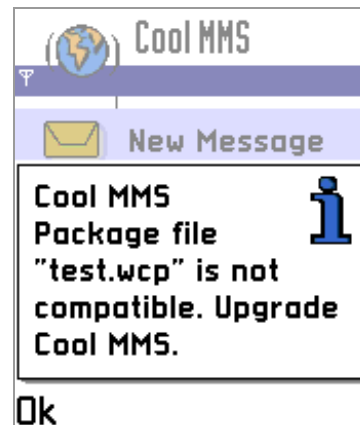

Removal

Notes:

- After the template(s) have been installed. **Cool MMS** cleans up and removes any unnecessary files created by the Cool MMS Template Package WCP install file.
- To remove a template from Cool MMS refer **Deleting a template** under the **Template** help section.

Getting Started

Opening the application will display the splash screen followed by the main view of the **Cool MMS** application as shown in **Figure 7**:

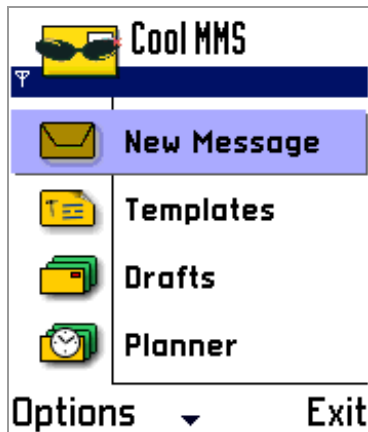

A summary of the menu items on the **Cool MMS** main menu:

- | | | |

|  | New Message | This item allows you to create, edit and send a new MMS message based on a Cool MMS template. |
|  | Templates | This item allows you to manage, preview and select your templates. |
|  | Drafts | This item allows you to manage and reuse your saved messages. |
|  | Planner | This item allows you to plan and send your messages based on important send dates and frequencies. |
|  | Settings | This item allows you to set your name, set max. MMS size for compatibility, contact filtering, view IMEI code and configure template servers to be used by the Go Online option |



Go Online

This item allows you to connect to the internet's **Cool MMS** template server pages displaying new templates and giving you the ability to download them.



New Message

The **New Message** menu item displays the **Editor** view that allows you to compose a new MMS message based on a **Cool MMS** template. The **Editor** view initially displays instructions and is shown in **Figure 8**:

After a template has been selected you can edit the user items, clear user items, add/remove recipients, save messages to drafts, send messages and plan messages.

Selecting the template

1. Select **Options**->**Select Template** or press the **Select** button. The **Templates** view will show a list of available template categories.
2. Use the scroll key to highlight the category and then select **Options**->**Open Folder** or press the **Select** button to view the templates in that folder.
3. Use the scroll key to highlight the template and then select **Options**->**Use Template**. The **Editor** view

will now display the selected template for editing.

Editing message items

1. Select **Options**-> **Edit Message**. A "Select page to edit" prompt will display with a list of pages which can be edited.
2. Use the scroll key to highlight the page number you intend to edit then press **Select**. A "Select items to edit" prompt will display a list of editable items for the selected page.
3. Use the scroll key to highlight the editable item you intend to edit then press **Select**.

Note: Using an image from camera

1. If you selected "Capture with camera", the view will switch to the camera application of the phone. Take the required shot and optionally rename the image. **Exit** the camera application to return to **Cool MMS "Select from"** prompt.
2. Use the scroll key to highlight the "Photo Album" item and then press **Select**. Select the recent shot taken with the camera with **Select**.

Note: Using a sound from recorder

1. If you selected "Record new sound", the view will switch to the recorder application of the phone. Record the sound and **Exit** the recorder application to return to **Cool MMS "Select from"** prompt.

Clearing the message items

1. Select **Options**-> **Clear Items**. An "Items" prompt will display a list of items which can be cleared.
2. Use the scroll key to highlight the item that you intend to clear then press **Select**. A "Clear item" confirmation dialog will display.
3. Select **Yes** to clear item.

Adding/removing recipients

Note:

- Cool MMS works closely with the phone's contact database. When

selecting recipients, the software will attempt to use the default MMS number (if specified), or alternatively if one is not specified it will attempt to use the mobile phone number. If however there is no mobile phone specified for the recipient, the software will attempt to use the contact's email. If all of these fail, the contact will not be allowed to be added.

- By default the contacts are filtered according to the above requirement and added to the list of contacts if valid. If you have many contacts then the process may take several seconds, to improve speed you can turn this option off by setting **Filter contacts** to **No** in the settings.

To add:

1. Select **Options**-> **Recipients**-> **Add**. A list of contacts from your phone will be shown. Use the horizontal scroll key to alternate between individuals or groups. Use the vertical scroll key to highlight items. Use the **Select** to select multiple individuals or groups then select **Add**.

To remove (view):

1. Select **Options**-> **Recipients**-> **View**. A list of selected contacts from your phone will show. Use the horizontal scroll key to alternate between individuals and groups. Use the vertical scroll key to highlight items. Use the **Select** to select multiple individuals or groups then select **Delete**.

Play/stop page sound

Note:

- Page must have a sound item.
- If the sound item is user defined, then it must have been edited by the user to be able to be played.

To play:

1. Select **Options**-> **Play Sound**.

To stop:

1. Select **Options**-> **Stop Sound**.

Sending the message

Notes:

- Software must be licensed.
 - Message must have at least one recipient.
 - The MMS sent can be viewed in the **sent** menu of the **Messaging** application of the phone. The sent message will have the description "Created by Cool MMS".
 - If a template's user item is not defined then it will not appear in the final MMS sent.
 - If the size of the message is greater than the limit set in the Settings menu, then additional time will be needed to compress the message to the best quality prior to sending.
1. Select **Options**->**Send**. A status dialog will indicate that message is being sent. Select **Cancel** to stop the message from being sent.

Planning the message

1. Select **Options**->**Planner**. This displays the **Planner** view. If the message has not been planned then a prompt will be displayed saying "**Add Draft to Planner**". If the message is already in the planner then it will highlight that selection. If you exit from the planner you will be brought back to the Cool MMS **Main** view. Please refer to the instructions for the **Planner** view.

Saving the message

Notes:

- All messages will be automatically saved to Drafts
 - You will be prompted for name if message is being saved for the first time.
1. Select **Options**->**Save**. After the message has been saved the **Editor** view closes.



Templates

The **Templates** menu item displays the **Templates** view that allows you install, manage and preview your templates. The **Templates** view also allows you to select a template to use in composing a new MMS message. The **Templates** view initially displays template categories (or folders) and is shown in **Figure 9**:

The Template folders are representative of the template categories and show the number of templates in that folder. To open the folder select **Options**->**Open Folder** or use the **Select** button. If the folder contains many templates and viewing for the first time then it may take several seconds to display the thumbnailed previews. Subsequent viewing will be much faster.

Managing template folders

Notes:

- Newly installed templates may create new folders representative of their category.

To create a new folder:

1. If not in folder view, switch to folder view as shown in **Figure 9**. Select **Options**->**Folder**->**New**. The "**Folder name**" prompt will be displayed.
2. Enter the new folder name and select **OK**. If the folder name already exists it will not be created.

To rename a new folder:

1. If not in folder view, switch to folder view as shown in **Figure 9**. Select **Options->Folder->Rename**. The "Rename folder" prompt will display.
2. Enter the new name for the folder and then select **OK**.

To delete a new folder:

Note:

- Only an empty folder can be deleted. If a folder that you want to delete contains templates you will have to move them to another folder or delete them.
1. If not in folder view, switch to folder view as shown in **Figure 9**. Select **Options->Folder->Delete**. The delete confirmation prompt will be displayed. Select **Yes**.

Installing new templates

Note:

- Refer to the above section **Installation/Removal of Cool MMS Templates**.

Using a template to create a new message

1. If not in template view, switch to template view by opening a folder. Use the scroll key to highlight the template you intend to use then select **Options->Use Template**. The Editor view will show with the selected template.

Previewing a template

Notes:

- Must be in template view to preview a template. If not in template view, switch to template view by opening a folder.
 - The navigation pane of the preview template view indicates the number of pages and shows the current page. A music icon appears if the current page has sound.
1. Use the vertical scroll key to highlight the template you intend to use then

- select **Options->Preview** or press **Select** button.
2. Use the horizontal scroll key or select **Next** to preview each page of template.
 3. To play the sound of a template page select **Options->Play Sound**. To stop the sound select **Options->Stop Sound**.
 4. Select **Back** to return to templates view.

Viewing template category and description

1. If not in template view, switch to template view by opening a folder. Use the scroll key to highlight the template you intend to view details. Select **Options->Details**. The "Templates details" dialog will show.

Moving a template to another folder

1. If not in template view, switch to template view by opening a folder. Use the scroll key to highlight the template you intend to move. Select **Options->Move To Folder**. The "Move To Folder" dialog will display with a list of folders.
2. Use the scroll key to highlight the folder and select **OK**.

Deleting a template

Notes:

- Deleting a template will automatically delete all saved drafts which were created based on this deleted template.
1. If not in template view, switch to template view by opening a folder. Use the scroll key to highlight the template you intend to delete. Select **Options->Delete**.
 2. The delete confirmation prompt will display. Select **Yes**.

Notes on Template contact fields

Templates can include contact fields that allows contact details of the recipient from the phones contact database to appear on the sent message. Fields can include given name <<GName>>, family name <<FName>>, phone <<Phone >>, email address <<EAddress>>, company <<Company>>, etc. This feature is useful for sending invitations as their name is automatically included in the message.

Drafts

The **Drafts** item displays the **Drafts** view that allows you manage your saved messages (drafts). The **Draft** view lists all saved drafts in alphabetically order as shown in **Figure 10**:

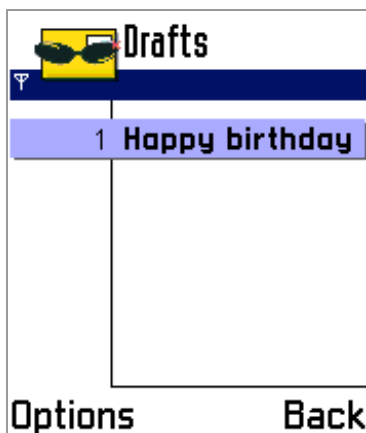

Editing a draft

1. Use the scroll key to highlight the draft you intend to edit. Select **Options->Edit**. The **Editor** view will display with the selected draft.

Deleting a draft

Notes:

- Deleting a saved draft will automatically delete all entries from the planner for this particular draft.

1. Use the scroll key to highlight the draft you intend to edit. Select **Options->Delete**. The delete confirmation prompt will display.
2. Select **Yes**.

Renaming a draft

1. Use the scroll key to highlight the draft you intend to edit. Select **Options->Rename**. The **"Rename draft"** prompt will display.
2. Enter the new name for the draft and then select **OK**.

Planning a draft

Notes:

- If the message has not been planned then a prompt will display **"Add Draft to planner"**. If the message is in the planner then it will be display highlighted.
1. Use the scroll key to highlight the draft you intend to edit. Select **Options->Planner**. This displays the **Planner** view. Please refer to the instructions for the **Planner** view.

Viewing draft's details

Notes:

- The draft details include creation date and time, category, MMS message's (not draft's) final minimum size, planned status and message recipient(s).
- The draft details may take several seconds to calculate the MMS message size if the draft contains many pages and requires compression for best quality.

1. Use the scroll key to highlight the draft you intend to view details. Select **Options->Draft Details** or **Select** button. The **"Draft details"** dialog will show.

Planner

The **Planner** menu item displays the **Planner** view that allows you plan the send dates of your saved drafts (messages). The

Planner view provides options to view details of your plan, edit a plan, edit a plan's draft, delete a plan, show (and search) and calendar. The planned drafts must be manually sent. The **Planner** view is shown in **Figure 11**:

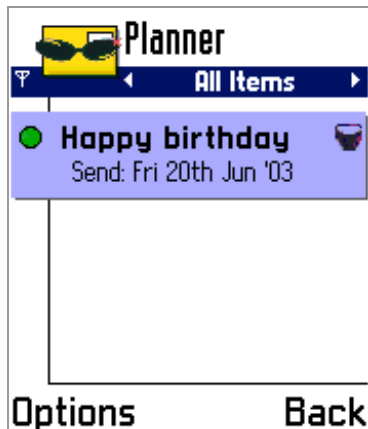

The **Planner** view organises the send dates of drafts into time categories of today, week, month, year and all items. These categories can be cycled by using the horizontal scroll keys. The icons of the planned drafts are:

- Send date today or in future. Message does not need sending.
- Send date in past. Message needs sending.
- Remove entry from planner after next send. Message (draft) or not deleted.

Adding a draft to the planner

Note:

- The **Planner** view does not have an option to add a draft. To add a draft to the **Planner** view, use the **Editor** or **Draft** view's **Options->Planner**. See the **Editor** or **Draft** view instructions for further information.

Viewing a planned draft details

Note:

- The plan details include draft name, planned send date, send frequency and if remove after send is enabled.

1. Use the scroll key to highlight the planned draft you intend to view details. Select **Options->Details** or **Select** button. The "Planned details" dialog will show.

Editing a planned draft's entry

Note:

- The planned entry has several fields to edit. These include send date, send frequency and remove entry after send.
 - Send frequency allows you to set if the draft is to be sent once, daily, weekly, monthly, yearly or disabled. If send disabled then the send option is not available. If frequency is set to daily, weekly, monthly or yearly then the send date will be automatically updated after send based on frequency value.
 - If Remove entry after send is set to yes then the entry will be removed from planner after the message is sent. It will not delete the messages draft.
1. Use the scroll key to highlight the planned draft entry you intend to view details. Select **Options->Edit->Planner Entry**. The planner entry form will show.
 2. Use the scroll key to highlight the field you intend to edit.
 3. To save changes select **Done** or to cancel changes select **Cancel**.

Editing a draft associated with planned entry

1. Use the scroll key to highlight the planned entry you intend to edit its draft. Select **Options->Edit->Draft**. The **Editor** view will display with the draft of the planned entry.

Deleting a planned entry

1. Use the scroll key to highlight the planned entry you intend to delete. Select **Options->Delete**.

2. The delete confirmation prompt will display. Select **Yes** to remove the entry (draft will not be deleted)

Showing time categories

Note:

- Showing time categories allows easy viewing of your planned drafts to show what needs sending.
1. Use the horizontal scroll key to cycle between time categories.
 2. Or, select **Options**->*Show* then use vertical scroll key to select time category. Special categories include *All* and *Search* which cannot be cycled.

Displaying phone's calendar

Note:

- Showing the phone's **calendar** allows you to get important dates to plan a draft's send date.
 - After exiting the **calendar** you will be brought back to the **Planner** view.
1. Select **Options**->*Calendar*. The phone's **calendar** will display. It is convenient to set the calendar default display to month for easy viewing.

Settings

The **Settings** menu item displays the **Settings** view that allows you to set or view the preferences of **Cool MMS**. This includes your name, maximum MMS size limit and online template servers. The Setting view allows you to view IMEI code of your phone required for purchasing an unlock key. The online template servers can be configured and used by the **Go Online** option. The **Settings** view is shown in **Figure 12**:

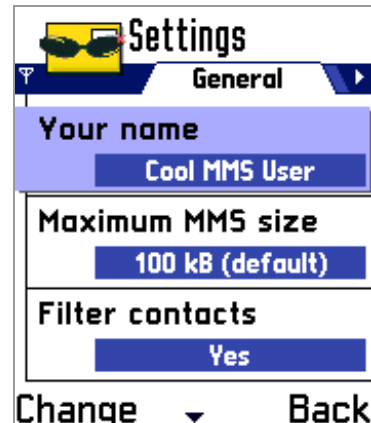

The settings are categorised into **General** and **Server**.

The general settings

Your name This is set to “Cool MMS User” by default. Your name is used in the **Editor** view when the instructions are displayed.

Maximum MMS size This is set to 100 kB by default. The maximum MMS size is used to limit the output size of the created MMS message.. See **Draft** details for MMS message size.

Filter contacts This is set to Yes by default. The filter contact option is used to show valid contacts in the add recipient list. A valid contact has a default MMS number/address set, or a mobile number or an email address. If you have a large amount of contacts it may take time to process and best to set Filter contacts to No.

Phone IMEI This displays the phone's IMEI code for easy viewing. The IMEI code is used for purchasing an unlock key.

Notes on maximum mms size

The maximum MMS size setting page provides three standard MMS size limits as shown in **Figure 13**.

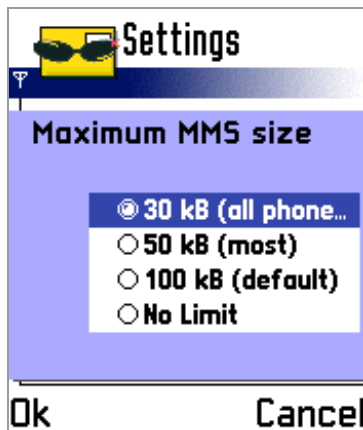

The maximum MMS size is specific to a particular make and model of a phone and can also be restricted by the telecommunication provider.

As an example, both Nokia 3650 / 7650 have a maximum allowed MMS size set to 100 kB whereas Nokia 6610 has a maximum allowed size of 30 kB. As a result, if you sent a 40 kB MMS to Nokia 6610 it would not be received.

If the composed MMS size is greater than the Maximum size limit (default 100 kB) in the settings, then **Cool MMS** will automatically compress the message to the best quality that is under the size limit. If the message cannot be compressed under the limit then a notification is shown informing that the settings must be adjusted or the message may be rejected.

By setting the maximum MMS size to 30 kB the MMS will be compatible with all phones.

The server settings

- The Server settings have two options **Template servers** and **Server in use**. The **Template servers** allows you to manage your servers and

Server in use selects the server to be used by the **Go Online** item of the **Main** view.

- As default, the "Wireless Central" template server is available.

Editing a server entry

- Must **Open** the **Templates servers** option of Server settings.
- You cannot edit the **Server name** for the default "Wireless Central" template server.

- Use the vertical scroll key to highlight the server to edit. Select **Options->Edit**. The server fields *Server name*, *User name*, *Password* and *URL address* are listed.
- Use the vertical scroll key to highlight the server field to edit.
- Select the **Change** or **Select** button to edit the field.

Creating a new server entry

- Must **Open** the **Templates servers** option of Server settings.
- The URL address field must be defined otherwise server cannot be added to server list.

- Select **Options->New**. The server fields *Server name*, *User name*, *Password* and *URL address* are listed.
- Use the vertical scroll key to highlight the server field to edit. The fields are *Server name*, *User name*, *Password* and *URL address*.
- Select the **Change** or **Select** button to edit the field.

Deleting a server entry

- Must **Open** the **Templates servers** option of Server settings.
- You cannot delete the default "Wireless Central" template server.

- Use the vertical scroll key to highlight the server to delete. Select **Options->Delete**.
- The delete confirmation prompt will display.
- Select **Yes** to remove the server entry.

Go Online

The **Go Online** menu item displays the **WAP browser** of the phone and connects to the currently selected template server as specified in the settings to display information about templates. You can browse available templates and download them to your phone with a click of a button. If **Cool MMS** is already running from the **WAP browser** or **Messaging** after an installation the **Go Online** option is not available to avoid recursion.

Unlocking Cool MMS

A unique unlock key must be purchased and entered to enable **Cool MMS** to send messages. If the unlock key has not been entered, an information dialog will appear daily on start-up and when attempting to send. The "Enter unlock key" prompt is shown in **Figure 14**.

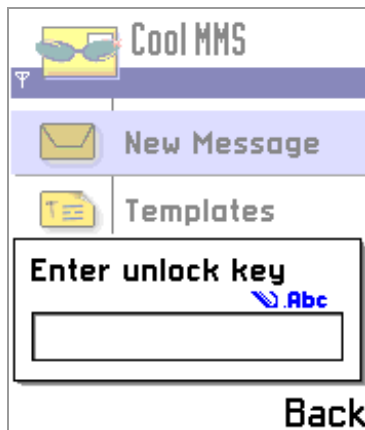

To receive the unlock key you must purchase the software and supply the phone's IMEI code. The IMEI code is found under the general category of the **Settings** view for your convenience. Please write down the unlock key for safekeeping.

Entering the unlock key

1. Go to the **Main** view of Cool MMS as shown in **Figure 7**. Select **Options->Unlock**. The "Enter unlock key" prompt will display as shown in **Figure 14**.
2. Enter the unlock key and then select **OK**. A confirmation note will be displayed to indicate successful registration.

Checking software registration

Notes:

- If **Cool MMS** is registered, no daily reminders will appear at start-up or when trying to send messages.
 - If registered the **Options->Unlock** menu disappears.
 - If registered the text "**This software has been licensed**" appears at the bottom of the "About Cool MMS" dialog.
1. Go to the main view of **Cool MMS** as shown in **Figure 7**. Select **Options->About Product**. The "About Cool MMS" dialog will display.
 2. Use the scroll key to scroll down to the bottom and confirm the text "This software has been licensed".
